- Site for Mobile Training Prop (approx. 200' x 250')
- Provide Propane for Live Fires
- Structural Pumps/Crash Vehicles
- 3 each 1 1/2" hoselines at 90 GPM min.
- Staff for IMS functions
- SCBA refill capability
- AFFF and Dry Chemical (optional)
- NFPA compliant PPE and SCBA



Description:

The 40-hour course will provide students with the necessary skills and knowledge they need for Airport Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting commitments. Training is conducted according to FAA FAR 139.319 and NFPA 1003, Standard for Airport Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications (2005 edition), requirements.
